Suite CRM on php. Create various types of applications for banking products by branches and transfer approval sheets and documents for them by departments.

- Elimination of software (implementation) and logical (task-setting) errors
- Fixing errors, consulting technical support and testers on the details of how algorithms work (code analysis and log parsing)
- Improvements to existing and creation of new functionality. A fitch of the type of duplication of an application from one module to another with certain fields, with copying documents from subpanels of the original (development of forwarding missing parameters to the php script of the duplicate saving module, duplication of documents using the ORM suite crm model, fixing emerging bugs in document hooks)
- Automation of business processes such as automatic creation of approval sheets and sending notifications to departments when creating/changing applications
- Composing complex sql queries with aggregation functions that implement business logic
- Writing scheduler tasks, setting up queues
- Frontend - small tasks in js with DOM, jquery, ajax and using libraries. Troubleshooting errors related to asynchrony
- Support and participation in the integration of the crm system with external API services with curl authorization, data bus (CFT, accepting applications from the bank's website, creating a legal opinion)
- CI/CD: participation in sprints, splitting release tasks into branches, transferring the release to stands from git, migrations, configuring configurations, clearing the cache, checking logs
- Writing instructions: related the release transfer to test benches, accounts and the protocol for working with them. Instructions for web application logs and nginx logs

Completion of the Sugar crm system of the sales office on php, nginx and MySQL server and Linux VM. Wholesale trade, hot calls, about 300 users and 1000 opportunities per day, calculation of prices and delivery times in cities, creation of necessary documents for the transaction, accounting of goods in warehouses, calls, working hours, salaries, integration with 1C

- Troubleshooting and refactoring legacy php and js code using the mvc pattern and SOLID, KISS, DRY programming principles
- Completion and creation of new CRM and fitch modules: managers' salary project and adding a test mode for calculating the PO when entering the expected completion. Automating the creation of price lists for mailing, setting up a time tracking script, shopping cart scripts, etc.
- Integration and support of the crm system with the API of external services such as kladr, Yandex maps, SberPay, the company's website on bitrix
- Configuring php scripts for remote procedure calls to transfer the implementation of transactions from crm to 1C postgresql database using a SOAP client
- Optimization of MySQL queries and tables in the database, setting up triggers, procedures, reports, table locks
- Automating manual tasks like synchronizing the HR staff calendar with the managers calendar in a deal to automatically change delivery dates when adding holidays
- Configuring cron php scripts for processing queues of transactions for synchronization with 1C in case of unavailability of the service
- Revision of cron php scripts for updating prices and balances from 1C. Parsing and loading leads
- Server operation monitoring, log analysis
- CRM User Support

There was no CI/CD, for about a year I worked on crm independently on tasks, interacted with a 1C programmer. The head of the department was a business analyst, the testers were mostly managers, the errors were monitored by the quality control department.

Most of the CRM errors have been fixed, and users have stopped complaining to support. The page loading speed has increased despite the complexity of the logic and the increase in the number of users.
